22x	Curriculum Consultant shared within the ISD					CW ISD	This was tried for one year and found not successful as the consultant was stretched too thin to be effective. The ISD currently supports, through a grant, curriculum consultant purchased services.
22x	ISD provided funds for LEA to Contract for Curriculum Consultant	CW ISD					This model has worked very effectively in implementing the districts school improvement plans.

23x	Sharing of superintendent with another LEA					CW LEA	This was attempted with other LEAs. None were interested in this arrangement.
23x	Part-time superintendent	LEA					The superintendent is now working 147 days instead of a full year. This has provided significant savings to the district and allowed continuity in leadership.

25x	Join ISD consortium for payroll and accounts payable and receivable					CW ISD	Quote from ISD for business services is \$18,000. District can hire part-time data entry person through a third party contract for \$10,000. This model was implemented in 2010-2011 with significant savings to the district.
<b>Operations and Maintenance</b>							
26x	District to request bids for part or all of maintenance and custodial services					TPC	Bids were requested for custodial and maintenance services. Bids received were significantly higher than the costs the district is paying to directly operate the services.
	Consortium bidding for capital improvement projects					CW ISD	This model has not provided any viable bidders as contractors in our region will not bid through this process.
<b>Pupil Transportation</b>							
27x	District to request bids for transportation services					TPC	Bids were requested and one bid received that was significantly higher than the cost the district is paying to directly provide the service.
27x	Contract with LEA for bus repair services					CW LEA	This was explored with 2 other neighboring districts and found to be more costly than doing the work with our staff.
<b>Other Central Administration</b>							
28x	Consortium bidding for copier services					CW ISD	We did an ISD wide bid for contracted copier services. The district awarded a contract and is experiencing significant savings on printer costs.
28x	ISD wide technical support					CW ISD	This plan was explored but did not occur because there were no significant savings to be had.
<b>Food Service and Athletics</b>							
29x	Sharing football and track facility					CW LEA	North Dickinson offered a constituent LEA the use of the football and track facility to a neighboring LEA. The neighboring LEA was able to develop a sharing of costs with their city government and thus did not need the use of our facility.
29x	District to request bids for food services					TPC CW LEA	The district discussed contract food services with neighboring LEA's. However none were interested in this arrangement. The district requested bids but no bids were received. The district reorganized the food service area and realized significant cost savings.
29x	Cooperative agreement for hockey					CW LEA	The district has been in a cooperative agreement with a neighboring school district for many years.
